<b>Description</b>	
Somehow, after migrating from foreman 1.7.4 to 1.8.2, duplicate interfaces appeared (especially on hosts with virtual nics and bridges).	
Trying to remove duplicate interfaces simply does not work.	
Howto reproduce:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• locate a host with duplicated interfaces (two br0 for example)</li><li>• try to remove one of the 'br0'</li><li>• submit</li><li>• application complains that one of the 'br0' are invalid</li></ul>
