<div>Description</div> <div>It's often difficult to figure out why Puppet classes are not being imported Foreman. Most of the time, it's due to some typo in the class it's self. It would be helpful if Foreman would present a useful error or notification when it encountered an error during class import. This would help the user determine what the problem may be.</div>
