3. Create new or assign existing host to newly created user as owner of host	
4. Edit user. Select default Organization and Default Locations from dropdowns	
5. Click Submit	
Actual results: Def Org and Loc are empty and dropdown lists are empty too. Not possible to assign Default Org and Loc. Right column in Organization tab is greyed User has no access to hosts in Default_Organization and Default_location	
Expected results: It's possible to modify Default Organizations and Locations.
