<p>When the foreman email is not properly configured, and a host is provisioned, it gets a 500 error when informing Foreman that it is built.</p> <p>Attached the production.log in this ticket.</p> <p>In the kickstart logs:</p> <pre>Informing Foreman that we are built --2016-02-11 10:57:40-- http://172.22.110.154/unattended/built?token=fgcfa081-a398-4333-b351-d3af03c0f3921 Connecting to 172.22.110.154:80... connected. HTTP request sent, awaiting response... 500 Internal Server Error 2016-02-11 10:57:42 ERROR 500: Internal Server Error.</pre> <p>Still the host is marked as built, as expected.</p> <p>Expected behavior: It logs in production.log that it can not send the email but returns 200.
