Content / Red Hat Subscriptions / show a Red Hat Enterprise Linux Server with Smart Management, Premium (Physical or Virtual Nodes) with 6 of 6 consumed. However if I go to Associations-> Content-Hosts I only show 4 content hosts subscribed." Some content hosts consume quantities greater than one. A quantity column should also be present on activation key association tab. |                           |
