A few points:

1. 1.8.0 is not a supported version, you should at least be on the latest point release and preferably on the current stable (1.11.2).
2. For support, please use IRC or the foreman-users mailing list - there's not enough information here to file a bug report, nor against such an old version.

It's very hard to say what might be happening on the 3-4th time compared to the first without comparing log files or something. I would ensure you have a DHCP smart proxy set up and configured and that when creating hosts you're setting all of the DHCP pre-requisites: <u>http://projects.theforeman.org/projects/foreman/wiki/Troubleshooting#No-DHCP-reservations-are-created-for-new-hosts</u>.
