Running foreman-proxy-0.3.3-0.1.noarch, installed on the PM.	
My puppet.conf defines environments like:	
<pre>[prod] modulepath = /etc/puppetlabs/puppet/env/prod/modules:/etc/puppetlabs/puppet/env/common/modules:/opt/puppet/share/puppet/modules manifest = /etc/puppetlabs/puppet/manifests/site.pp pluginsync = true</pre>	
When I query the proxy for classes in the "prod" environment, I see:	
<pre>[root@fc-wrpupem01 manifests]# wget -q -O - http://localhost:8443/puppet/environments/prod {"paths": "/etc/puppetlabs/puppet/env/prod/modules/et/puppetlabs/puppet/env/common/modules/opt/puppet/share/puppet/modules", name": "prod"}[root@fc-wrpupem01 manifests]#</pre>	
It would appear that proxy is ignoring the delimiters (":") and concatenating the entire string.
