1. From "Hosts," click on a host.
2. On the host properties page, click "Reports"
3. Click on a report that had an error.
4. Change the "Show Log Messages" dropdown to "Errors Only" or "Warnings Or Errors"

While the filter does show errors only, or warnings/errors, it also shows "info" reports. This may be the intention of this function, though. I don't mind it.
