<p>My foreman is on the same host as my puppetmaster and I want to use storeconfigs. There are two problems:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1) Foreman doesn't detect that I am using storeconfigs2) The "using_storeconfigs" setting in settings.yaml doesn't fix this <p>My settings.yaml looks like:</p> <pre>:unattended: false :puppetconfdir: /etc/puppet/puppet.conf :login: false :require_ssl: false :using_storeconfigs: true</pre> <p>The puppetconfdir is correct here.</p> <p>I've done a little bit of debugging. I think the problem is in "default_settings/loader.rb". The line being:</p> <pre>set('using_storeconfigs', "Foreman is sharing its database with Puppet Store configs",(!Puppet.settings.instance_variable_get(:@values)[:master][:dbadapter].empty? rescue false)),</pre> <p>If I replace the last expression simply with "true" everything works. I tried to dump the contents of @values via:</p> <pre>Puppet.settings.instance_variable_get(:@values).inspect</pre> <p>and got</p> <pre>{:user=>{}, :cli=>{}, :memory=>{:bindaddress=>"0.0.0.0"}, :main=>{}, :mutable_defaults=>{}, :production=>{}}</pre> <p>I am on a recent commit in the dev branch.</p> <p>Thanks.</p>
