As they were meant to be rebuilt, the foreman erased their configuration status.</p> <p>The status of the hosts is show as errored in the hosts list.</p> <p>However, the filter global_status = error does not show them.</p> <p>It does however show a node with "token expired" AND configuration = OK.</p> <p>So:</p> <p>Expected:</p> <p>global_status = error returns hosts with:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Configuration = OK and build = ERROR- Configuration = ERROR and build = OK- Configuration = nil and build = ERROR <p>Actual result:</p> <p>global_status = error returns hosts with:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Configuration = OK and build = ERROR- Configuration = ERROR and build = OK <p>global_status = error does NOT return hosts with:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Configuration = nil and build = ERROR
