<p>I've just upgraded to Foreman 1.0, and I can't save changes/create new provisioning templates. Exact steps for both cases:</p> <p>For editing a template:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Go to Provisioning Templates, edit any template2. Add/change anything3. Click Submit4. Message says template saved5. Open up template, change isn't there <p>However, it does work if you make your change, click on Preview, then click on Submit.</p> <p>For creating a template:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Go to Provisioning Templates, click on New Template2. Enter name, template type, type something in Template editor3. Click Save4. Message says template saved, but the template does not appear in the list <p>This occurs for both Firefox and Chrome (latest versions of both).</p>
