<p>The Kafo README.md suggests:</p> <pre>It is recommended to prefix the migration names with date +%y%m%d%H%M%S to avoid migration ordering issues.</pre> <p>Likewise the examples show:</p> <pre>cat <<EOF > "/etc/foreman/installer-scenarios.d/foreman-installer.migrations/`date +%y%m%d%H%M%S`-gutterball.rb"</pre> <p>Foreman opted instead to use +Y and an _ to prefix a migration. It would be ideal if Foreman would adopt the Kafo reccomendation, it's harder to move migrations from Foreman to Katello with the way it is now.</p> <p>The migrations would have to be renamed, and the .applied filed updated in a hook or RPM script.</p>
