<p>When deploying foreman using foreman-installer and NOT defining an admin password, foreman gets deployed and a message is displayed with the url and a random admin password.</p> <p>If you try to redeploy foreman, but this second time assigning the admin password via <code>--foreman-admin-password="Password"</code>, when foreman gets deployed, it shows the url and the admin password as "Password" but when trying to login you get an invalid password message.</p> <p>If you try to login using the original random password, you will be able to access the GUI.</p> <p>I recall seeing this behavior as back as 1.7 release.</p> <p>IB</p>
