### Description

Templates are generated using url\_for() which causes the templates to get the base url of the foreman server from the user's web browser address. This is incorrect if you're installing Foreman locally and accessing <a href="http://localhost:3000/">http://localhost:3000/</a>

We should instead use the Settings[:foreman\_url] value to construct the URLs. Patch incoming.
