<b>Description</b> using foreman-installer (no options) on a fresh OS install, the WEB UI comes up with "The security certificate presented by this website was not issued by a trusted certificate authority" on Chrome, IE, Firefox and no way to ignore the error. This seems to be around "HSTS" being active and self signed certs. Ideally I would like to install with SSL certs but I will be happy for a working web UI with self signed.
