url for :controller => '/home'

In particular, a leading slash ensures no namespace is assumed. Thus, while url\_for :controller => 'users' may resolve to Admin::UsersController if the current controller lives under that module, url\_for :controller => '/users' ensures you link to ::UsersController no matter what.
