<b>Description</b> I upgraded to 1.1 RC1 and created a new Org. When I go to edit a host and change the Org it changes it from oVirt to Bare Metal and refuses to assign it to the new org saying that the host already exists. If I change it back to Ovirt I just get a blank page that says '2012' and it still is not assigned to the new Org.
