<p>When I'm filtering hosts according to hostgroups I would expect the "hostgroup ~ foo" to match hosts that has foo in their ancestry, not just in their last hostgroup name.</p> <p>E.g. if a host is in these hierarchical hostgroups: foo/bar/baz - we can only search or match for baz now, foo or bar is completely invisible in the filtering.</p> <p>Please add this functionality. If you don't want to break or modify previous searches, add something like "fullhostgroup" to search according to that.</p> <p>Thanks, A.</p>
