<p>Currently PuppetSetting raises an exception when the return code of the puppet master --configprint command is bad. This is usually down to configuration, but there's not enough debug to help.</p> <p>It currently raises this message:</p> <pre>unable to get [:hostcert, :localcacert, :hostprivkey, :storeconfigs] Puppet setting: &lt;stdout&gt; ;</pre> <p>It should also provide the path to puppetmasterd it ran (as people have had \$PATH issues), the full command (to include the puppet.conf location) and stderr.</p>
