<p>our hostgroups have compute profiles, subnets & operating system details configured.</p> <p>so basically all needed to create a host via command line is this:</p> <pre>hammer host create --hostgroup-id \${GROUP} --build true --name \${HOST} --compute-resource-id 1</pre> <p>when trying to switch to hostgroup-title like this:</p> <pre>hammer host create --hostgroup-title \${GROUP} --build true --name \${HOST} --compute-resource-id 1</pre> <p>hammer now complains with this:</p> <pre>Could not create the host: Error: At least one of options --architecture, --architecture-id is required</pre> <p>See: <code>'hammer host create --help'</code></p> <p>it seems like when switch to houstgroup-title, hammer or foreman is not able to figure out the OS details configured with the hostgroup</p>
