| <p>After using the installer to install 1.1rc5 the foreman-proxy only responds with "connection reset by peer". A workaround is to comment out the following three lines in the config:</p> <pre>#:ssl_ca_file: /var/lib/puppet/ssl/certs/ca.pem #:ssl_certificate: /var/lib/puppet/ssl/certs/foreman11.local.pem #:ssl_private_key: /var/lib/puppet/ssl/private_keys/foreman11.local.pem</pre> <p>After that the proxy starts to work.</p> | |

Make sure you use an HTTPS URL (<https://...>), since with those three config options enabled, it will listen for SSL connections on port 8443. When commented, it expects HTTP on 8443.
