<p>I'm working on getting Foreman to manage my entire build cycle. Anyhoo, I've got some hosts that Foreman created on my VMware vCenter server that I can't seem to Delete in the Foreman web GUI. When I click Delete for the host, I get:</p> <pre>Failed to remove jasontest.mydomain.com from the autosign file: 406 Not Acceptable</pre> <p>I have to autosign entries whatsoever. Now, when I click Unmanage Host in Foreman, I get the following when I try to Delete:</p> <pre>Failed to destroy a compute myvcenterhost (VMWare) instance jasontest.mydomain.com: ActiveRecord::RecordNotFound</pre> <p>Which may be because I deleted the corresponding VM directly from vCenter.</p> <p>The build was kind of in limbo (the VM was created in VMware vcenter, but no OS was installed yet), so I clicked Cancel Build at one point. Lemme know if you need more info here.</p> <p>Oh I'm running Foreman 1.1RC5 on CentOS 6.3 and using Firefox 18 when working in the foreman gui.</p>
