The Debian package, when installed from apt as documented in the Getting Started guide, does not install rubygems together with it. However the installer requires "rubygems", so the installation fails immediately:

/usr/share/foreman-installer/generate_answers.rb:3:in `require': no such file to load -- rubygems
(LoadError)

The Debian highline package installs the code to the ruby system library path, therefore rubygems is not needed. We should wrap the require in a rescue block...
