Steps to reproduce: 1) log in as admin 2) create john as an admin with no location/organization		
<ul> <li>3) assign john as an owner of some-host.example.com (host is in Default Organization/Default Location)</li> <li>4) create beth with manager role in Default Organization/Default Location</li> <li>5) log out, log in as beth</li> </ul>		
<ul><li>6) edit some-host.example.com, go to 'Additional Information' tab</li><li>7) notice john is not set as owner (dropdown has a blank value set) and is not available in dropdown selection</li></ul>		

8) Hit the submit when owner dropdown has empty value selected, revisit 'Additional Information' again
9) beth is now owner of some-host
