Under Ruby 1.9, when multiple base errors are logged (e.g. when saving a smart proxy and it's unable to query it, bad URL etc) the UI shows:	
Unable to save [" Unable to communicate with the proxy: Connection reset by peer ", " Please check the proxy is configured and running on the host before saving. "]	
Note the array syntax around the strings.
