Description Currently we sometimes use the syntax <pre>gem 'safemode', '~> 1.3', '>= 1.3.4'</pre> which is equivalent to <pre>gem 'safemode', '>= 1.3.4', '< 2'</pre> . The latter is easier to handle in a script to generate RPM dependency statements.
