We had a second cluster created for ManagelQ and I went to remove a hosts interface and add a new one - to my surprise no interfaces populated (there were not created yet in the cluster for testing manageiq). Once I deleted that cluster it worked as expected (save for the error I seem to get for all edits: http://projects.theforeman.org/issues/2316)
