Description	
There should be an audit record created while using external auth source and the external group membership changes for a user (on the remote side)	
<ul style="list-style-type: none">- set up an external auth source (e.g. freeIPA)- create a user on it- create an external group on it- login with the external user id- (the user should be created)- on foreman, create a user group and map it to the external group you created- hit refresh to load the user mappings (the ext. user should be added to the UG)- now, on the external auth source, remove the user from the group- on foreman, navigate to the UG and at the external group mapping tab, hit refresh again- (the user should be removed from the group)- list all audits and notice, the action is not audited at all
