On deletion however this was omitted (also means you aren't able to ascertain with the API response that you have, in-fact, tried to delete a valid puppetclass).</p> <p>Should be able to do something like this;</p> <pre>-X DELETE <a href="https://foreman/api/v2/hosts/testhost/puppetclass_ids/ntp">https://foreman/api/v2/hosts/testhost/puppetclass_ids/ntp</a></pre> <p>or, indeed</p> <pre>-X DELETE <a href="https://foreman/api/v2/hosts/testhost/puppetclass_ids/invalid_class">https://foreman/api/v2/hosts/testhost/puppetclass_ids/invalid_class</a> response = Error</pre>
