Instructions: =====

1. yum-config-manager --enable rhel-7-server-optional-rpms
2. yum -y install <https://yum.puppetlabs.com/puppet5/puppet5-release-el-7.noarch.rpm>
3. yum -y install <https://dl.fedoraproject.org/pub/epel/epel-release-latest-7.noarch.rpm>
4. yum -y install https://yum.theforeman.org/releases/1.16/el7/x86_64/foreman-release.rpm
5. yum -y install foreman-installer

Error1: =====

First issue: GPC key error which resolved manually installing key, the following bug over a year ago manually fixed:

Error 2: =====

Package: foreman-proxy-1.17.1-1.el7.noarch (foreman)

Requires: rubygem(rake) >= 0.8.3

rubygem 0.8.3 required which it does not install; tried installing manually and Foreman still fails

Is there any definitive instructions to install on Redhat which works?, I also followed <https://fedoraproject.org/wiki/EPEL> which still did not work
