<b>Actual results:</b> "You currently don't have any Content Views. A Content View can be added by using the button on the right." But there is no button on the right	
<b>Expected results:</b> Some other message saying I don't have access	
<b>Additional info:</b> I went through multiple Foreman pages and they don't mention creation. User either is presented the button or not. Perhaps Katello could do the same.
