When you were logged previously and you session expired and you come from Signo for the first time, you see warning that session has expired resulting in logout action. To login again you must reenter '/' url. We should set expiration in future immediately after successful Signo login.

We set new expiration interval when user logs in successfully using any kind of SSO. Also this patch moves logout path out of thread variable and stores it into a session. This is more secure storage for threaded servers.
