<p>belongs_to_proxy ignores the `required` option, so you can set invalid proxy ID's, which ends up hitting database constraints. For example:</p> <pre>\$ hammer -u admin -p changeme realm create --name Potato --realm-proxy-id '941' --realm-type FreeIPA Could not create the realm: PG::ForeignKeyViolation: ERROR: insert or update on table "realms" violates foreign key constraint "realms_realm_proxy_id_fk" DETAIL: Key (realm_proxy_id)=(941) is not present in table "smart_proxies". : INSERT INTO "realms" ("name", "realm_type", "realm_proxy_id", "created_at", "updated_at") VALUES (\$1, \$2, \$3, \$4, \$5) RETURNING "id"</pre> <p>Whereas it should say something like this:</p> <pre>\$ hammer -u admin -p changeme realm create --name Potato --realm-proxy-id '941' --realm-type FreeIPA Could not create the realm: Realm proxy was not found</pre>
