I seem not to be able to build non-SCL plugins at the moment: http://koji.katello.org/koji/taskinfo?taskID=132508		
The issue is that the build (rightfully) expects the result to have %{foremandist} set to fm1_20, but the built RPMs don't have that.		
I think this is because of the recent split out of the foreman-release package into an own source package, and the move of the RPM macros to foreman-build which is not installed in the buildroots (<u>http://koji.katello.org/koji/rpmlist?buildrootID=40939%20&start=150ℴ=external_repo_name&type=component</u>).		
This does not happen in 1.18/1.19, as there foreman-release is installed in the buildroots.		
The SCL buildroots seem to have foreman-build installed.
