<b>Description of problem:</b> There's no way to revert to the original version of the template. Once user makes a change, there is a new revision created and user can only revert to this version. It should be possible to revert to the original by undoing the first revision.	
<b>How reproducible:</b> always	
<b>Steps to Reproduce:</b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. create or clone a provisioning template</li><li>2. save it</li><li>3. the 'History' will be empty</li><li>3. change the template, save</li><li>4. in the History tab, there's the revision containing the diff of the original state and the new state</li><li>5. from now on, user can only get to the first changed version (by clicking "revert to this version"), but not to the original version</li><li>6. one is unable to get to the original, unchanged version</li></ol>
