Description

Description of problem:

When pressing the Power Off button on a Libvirt VM in Foreman, I get a message that the VM is now Running and the button shown in the VM dialog is still the Power Off one.

How reproducible:

always on Libvirt compute resource

Steps to Reproduce:

1. go to Infrastructure -> Compute resources -> <Libvirt resource> -> Virtual Machines
2. Power Off one of the VMs found

Actual results:

The VM is actually and really powered off but Foreman declares success for the VM now Running *and* still shows the "Power Off" button in the VM dialog then appearing.

If I then click again on the "Power Off" button, it executes actually a "Power On".

Expected results:

Foreman congratulates me to the VM now stopped and shows the "Power On" button.

Additional info:

The UI does not reflect the actual state of the VM. It takes a little while for the VM to power down, but the refresh after submit is 'too quick' and does not pick up the changes. When I refreshed the page after the VM powered, everything was as expected.
