<b>Description</b> I have a VMware network that includes a '/' in it (forward slash). When a node is provisioned using this network, the compute node is created with a network with the forward slashes replaced with an encoded value (%2f, in this case). I suspect it also occurs with other characters which are valid in the VMware network namespace.
