<p><a href="#">#25102</a> was merged recently and it contains a number of migrations with the exact same timestamp as some previously existing migrations in REX.</p> <p>This causes an error when you upgrade a system where REX was installed before (db:migrate):</p> <pre>ActiveRecord::DuplicateMigrationVersionError:</pre> <pre>Multiple migrations have the version number 20150616080015.</pre> <p>I can't see a reason why this wouldn't happen on production too during an upgrade, even if we remove the migrations from REX, the timestamps are still saved in memory.</p>
