Description The RPM provides a /usr/share/foreman/tmp symlink, which points to /var/run/foreman, which is supplied in the package. On Fedora 18, this is a volatile area and so the package should supply a tmpfiles.d configuration file to recreate it after boot (the proxy already does this).
