The JSON response for /puppetclasses (without /api) does not paginate the results. It returns on the puppetclasses in Foreman.
The JSON response for /api/puppetclasses paginates the results according to the parameters :page and :per_page. If you want all the results, pass :per_page in the URL like this below.

/api/puppetclasses?per_page=100000

If there is no parameter passed, it takes the default in Settings, which is why the response was different.

By the way, the JSON responses in the UI controllers (without /api/) are going to be deprecated soon, so there is no reason to paginate the response.
Can I close this issue?
