Hi Alex,

Firstly don't worry about the distribution information, not all repositories have it.

I've synced both of the OCS repositories you've sent and added their subscription to a Katello client using Katello 3.12. When I did `sudo subscription-manager repos --list`, I saw the two OCS repos and could enable them. Is that what you're trying to do?

A couple things could be happening. Did you remember to add the proper subscription for your OCS repositories to the Katello client? That could cause the repositories to not show up. Also, if you're using content views or lifecycle environments you should double check that your client is configured to use the correct content view and lifecycle environment.
