<b>Description of problem:</b> In Hammer, while generating "Applied Errata" report, I can't set input Status=all. This is due to "all" not being explicitly set as a possible option in the report template. In WebUI, it's sufficient to leave the field empty while in Hammer, some of the options must be selected, forcing the user to only select errata with specific status.

<b>Steps to Reproduce:</b> 1. # hammer report-template generate --id 113 --inputs 'Filter Errata Type'='all','Include Last Reboot'=yes Input Status: Value is not included in the list 2.# hammer report-template generate --id 113 --inputs 'Filter Errata Type'='all','Include Last Reboot'=yes,Status=all Input Status: Value is not included in the list	
<b>Actual results:</b> Must select one of the statuses, e.g. "success" or "warning"	
<b>Expected results:</b> Hammer shouldn't force me to filter errata by status
