<b>Description</b> <p>The current Environment implementation in Foreman allows you to delete an Environment even if there are Hosts using it.</p> <p>When you delete it, the Hosts are left with no puppet Environment.</p> <p>There could be potential issues with this. (There could be different modules or templates in the default Environment)</p> <p>It would be better if Foreman at least warned that some Hosts are using the Env.</p> <p>Ideally, the Admin should reassign the Env to a different one before deleting it.</p> <p>Foreman could also mention that.</p>
