<p>The current Environment implementation in Foreman allows you to delete an Environment even if there are Hosts using it.</p> <p>When you delete it, the Hosts are left with no puppet Environment. There could be potential issues with this. (There could be different modules or templates in the default Environment)</p> <p>It would be better if Foreman at least warned that some Hosts are using the Env.</p> <p>Ideally, the Admin should reassign the Env to a different one before deleting it. Foreman could also mention that.</p>
