Difficulty:

Currently the services run unconfined because pulpcore-selinux only labels /usr/{local,lib/pulp}/bin/{gunicorn,rq} but RPM packages install to /usr/bin/{gunicorn,rq}. Labelling those with pulpcore_exec_t feels incorrect so I'm suggesting to introduce /usr/libexec/pulpcore/{gunicorn,rq} wrappers with the correct SELinux labels.

In python3-pulpcore 3.7.1-2 the /usr/libexec/pulpcore wrappers have been introduced to enter the proper SELinux domain.

It has also been cherry picked to 3.6.3-2 but in the SELinux policy is incomplete so it has no effect. The main benefit of that cherry pick is to keep the module compatible with both 3.6 and 3.7.
