That is also unwieldy in the much more common "class foo" instance: click "foo", wait for the expansion (which frequently is just "foo") and then click the new "foo".

For classes "foo", "foo::foo", "foo::bar", it should be more like:

Click "foo" to add "class foo". Click "+" to get:
