### Class tagging is too unwieldy

<p>Currently, to distinguish between "foo" and "foo::foo" requires 2 clicks and at least 2 delays. (Click "foo". Delay for list expansion. Hover over one of the newly-listed "foo" and delay - if it is correct, click it. If not, repeat.)</p> <p>That is also unwieldy in the much more common "class foo" instance: click "foo", wait for the expansion (which frequently is just "foo") and then click the new "foo".</p> <p>For classes "foo", "foo::foo", "foo::bar", it should be more like:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>foo</b> [+]</li></ul> <p>Click "foo" to add "class foo". Click "+" to get:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>foo</b> [+]<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>◦ foo</li><li>◦ bar</li></ul></li></ul> <p>Clicking <b>foo</b> gives "foo". Clicking 'foo' gives "foo::foo" and clicking 'bar' gives "foo::bar"</p>
