<p>Currently it is not possible to create an unmanaged host and assign puppet classes without completing Network and Operating system tab when running foreman in :unattended: true".</p> <p>If a client is in a transition phase on migrating the infrastructure to foreman it would be nice to be able to run foreman in :unattended: true mode even if at the beginning foreman is only used as a node classifier. This should also show clients the full potential of foreman and not just the node classifier and reporting features.</p> <p>Currently transitioning client are stuck running :unattended: false as they can't use foreman :unattended:true as a node classifier only.</p> <p>So it would be nice to have an (Un)Manage Host button on the New Host page to create initial host and after add them to the different tabs when ready.</p>
