<p>If you are migrating and run the external-node importer, it should overwrite the class list for each host with the new information each time. (Instead, it combines them.)</p> <p>Starting node info:</p> <pre>--- classes: - base - class2 - class3 - class4 parameters: ...</pre> <p>Run the import:external_nodes. Foreman shows (correctly) base, class2, class3, class4. Edit the node in the external tool:</p> <pre>--- classes: - base - class2 - class5 parameters: ...</pre> <p>(Remove class3, class4. Add class5.) rake import:external_nodes again. Foreman will now show "base, class2, class3, class4, class5" - the removed classes do not go away.</p>
