<b>Description</b>		
When you run the rake task apipie:cache:index it prints a message that the cache is out of date:  API controllers newer than Apipie cache! Run apipie:cache rake task to regenerate cache.  Since this is the command to actually generate that cache, the user shouldn't be bothered with it.

When you run the rake task apipie:cache:index it prints a message that the cache is out of date:

```
API controllers newer than Apipie cache! Run apipie:cache rake task to regenerate cache.
```

Since this is the command to actually generate that cache, the user shouldn't be bothered with it.

This approach uses `Foreman.in_rake?` to determine which task runs rather than parsing ARGV manually.
